

HELP! I DON'T UNDERSTAND WHAT'S GOING ON!

Welcome! Firstly, don't panic! This guide will talk you through everything you need to have the best possible trip. To begin, what makes up Disney World Orlando?

There are seven theme parks:

MAGIC KINGDOM

This is probably the park which comes to mind when you think of Disney. It has Cinderella's Castle as its focal point and contains some of the most well known rides, including Big Thunder Mountain and Space Mountain.

ANIMAL KINGDOM

This park is themed around the natural world and animal conservation. It is the largest of the four parks at 580 acres. As well as rides and shows, it also hosts hundreds of live animals, including gorillas, elephants and tigers.

HOLLYWOOD STUDIOS

This park was previously known as MGM Studios and is dedicated to the world of film, television, music and theater. It is where you will find the two newest lands; Toy Story Land and Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge and some of the most popular attractions like Star Wars: Rise of the Resistance.

EPCOT

This park is dedicated to technological innovation and international culture. Its icon is Space-ship Earth, which resembles a giant golf ball. It is split into two lands - Future World and World Showcase. World Showcase is made up of 11 different pavillions, each themed around a country. If you are a foodie, you will want to be sure to have an EPCOT day.

BLIZZARD BEACH

Discover a flurry of fun at Disney's Blizzard Beach water park at, including waterslides, raft rides, a lazy river and more Blizzard Beach hosts 12 main attractions stretching out over its 66 acres. The theme of the park is an old ski resort where you'll find alpine-inspired buildings and melting snow sculptures abound. The park is organized by "slopes", and there's even a working ski lift to take you to the peak of Mount Gushmore.

TYPHOON LAGOON

The older of the 2 water parks, Typhoon Lagoon turned a tropical paradise into a natural waterpark. You'll find boats, surfboards and nautical wreckage strewn all around the park, lying wherever the storm happened to toss them. Typhoon Lagoon home to the two newest rides, which were part of a 2003 addition: Crush N Gusher, a 400-foot tall "water coaster" set in an abandoned fruit-processing plant. And Miss Adventure Falls, an exhilarating family raft ride that's home to Duncan the Parrot — Disney's first and only animatronic installed in a waterpark.

DISNEY SPRINGS

Disney Springs is an outdoor shopping, dining, and entertainment complex at the Walt Disney World Resort. Here, you can find an eclectic mix of unique shops, one-of-a-kind restaurants and lively entertainment. Disney Springs does NOT require a park ticket so it is totally free to enter which makes it great for non-park days

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

To enter a Walt Disney World theme park, each Guest must have:

- A Disney World Theme Park Ticket
- A theme park reservation—made via the new Disney Park Pass system (we'll get to this later)—along with valid park admission for the same park on the same day.

Also, it's highly recommended to have:

 The latest version of the My Disney Experience app on your mobile device, with location services and notifications enabled

RESERVATIONS FOR PARK ENTRY

Since the parks reopened in 2020, park attendance is now managed through the Disney Park Pass system, which guests will use to make theme park reservations. To enter a park, both a park reservation AND valid admission for the same park on the same date are required for each person in your party ages 3 and up (limit one park per day).

To enter a theme park, all Guests ages 3 and older must have a theme park reservation in addition to valid admission for the same park on the same date (limit one park per day). At this time a theme park reservation is not required to visit a water park, however, theme park reservation requirements are subject to change. For the time being, all Guests will be required to make a reservation in advance for each park entry. If you have a multi-day ticket, you will be required to make a park reservation for each date of your visit.

WHAT ABOUT PARK HOPPING?

For all park-hopper tickets, guests will ONLY have to make a park reservation for the first park they plan to visit that day. Guests do not need a reservation for the park(s) they plan to hop to at 2PM EST. You must scan into the park you made a reservation for before you enter the second park of the day.



DISNEY PARK PASS SYSTEM

The Disney Park Pass system is now open to Guests with valid admission. The number of Disney Park Pass reservation days you can hold at one time varies based on your plans:

- Disney Resort and other select hotel Guests with valid theme park admission can make reservations for their length of stay.
- Annual Passholders can make theme park reservations for up to 3 days at a time or for their length of stay if staying at a Disney Resort or other select hotel.
- Existing ticket holders can make reservations for the number of days of valid theme park admission.

If you booked a vacation package, your ticket eligibility is tied to your package travel dates. To make a park reservation for a different date, be sure to modify your vacation package dates.

If you have a room-only reservation at a Disney Resort or other select hotel for a stay, please call the Disney Reservation Center or call your travel professional to upgrade to a vacation package with tickets—and then make your theme park reservations.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I WANT TO BOOK A NEW VACATION?

You can purchase new Disney Resort hotel packages, purchase new theme park tickets and make park reservations for arrivals starting in 2023. Guests will be able to view park reservation availability online prior to purchasing tickets.

Step 1: Confirm Your Admission Is Linked to Your Disney Account

To get started, you'll need valid park admission that's linked to your Disney account

- First, sign in to your Disney account, which is where your Walt Disney World plans are stored and managed. If you do not have a Disney account, you'll need to create an account.
- Be sure that your current address is reflected in your Disney account.
- Then, confirm that your valid admission is linked to your Disney account. If it's not, then please

link your admission now. All Guests in your party must also have valid park admission linked to their profile.

• If you'll be staying at a Disney Resort hotel, confirm that your Disney Resort hotel reservation is linked to your Disney account as well. Now you're ready to make a park reservation!

Step 2: Create Your Party

- When you begin to make a reservation, you'll be prompted to create your party from your Family & Friends list.
- Simply select the family and friends you'd like to include, then select "Continue".
- Don't see someone in your travel party? Select "Add a Guest" to include them.

Note: You may need to make more than one Disney Park Pass reservation for your party depending on your admission type. Please make sure your party consists of Annual Passholders or theme park ticket holders.

Staying in a Disney Resort or other select hotel with a package that includes tickets? Everyone in your party must also have a hotel reservation. If this varies, you will need to make separate Disney Park Pass reservations.

Step 3: Select a Date and Park

- Choose the date and the theme park that you'd like to visit from the available reservations. Please note that dates and theme park selections are limited and subject to availability.
- After creating your party in the Disney Park Pass system, you'll be prompted to:
 Select a Date: View a calendar and choose one of the available dates for your visit.

Select a Theme Park: Park hours will be displayed for your convenience. After selecting your date, park, you can confirm your reservation.

Step 4: Review and Confirm Your Plans

- Carefully review and confirm your selected park and date. If you need to make any changes, select "Back" to revise your selections.
- Before confirming, you'll need to agree to the Terms & Conditions. Then, select "Confirm" to complete your park reservation.
- Once confirmed, your reservation will appear in My Plans.
- Want to make another park reservation? Select "Make Another Reservation" to continue planning. As a reminder, if you have a multi-day ticket, you will be required to make a park reservation for each date of your visit.
- Your new reservation(s) will appear in My Plans—both online and in the My Disney Experience app.
- If you need to cancel a reservation, view your daily itinerary in My Plans, then select "Reservation Details".

DISNEY GENIE+

WHAT IS THE DISNEY GENIE PLUS?

The Disney Genie Plus is the paid service which allows guests to skip the lines at participating Disney attractions through what is called the "Lightning Lane". The Disney Genie Plus service is available the morning of your park visit and guests can begin to make their first ride selection at 7:00 AM.

WHAT IS THE DISNEY LIGHTNING LANE?

The Disney Lightning Lane is the skip the line queue available to anyone who upgraded their Disney World ticket to include the Disney Genie Plus. The Lightning Lane is the opposite of the regular standby line and it will be shorter. Guests can choose an arrival window for one ride at a time and once their arrival window has opened each guests will enter the ride using the Lightning Lane for that attraction. It's important to note that the Disney Lightning Lanes are also different from any ride participating in the Disney virtual queue system.

IS LIGHTNING LANE THE SAME AS GENIE PLUS?

It's important to note that the Disney Lightning Lane and Genie Plus service are not one in the same. The Lightning Lane is the skip the line queue which replaced the old FastPass queue, while the Disney Genie Plus is the actual paid service which will allow you to choose a return time to enter the Lightning Lane.


WHAT IS THE COST OF GENIE+ AT DISNEY WORLD?

The Disney Genie+ service starts at \$15, but can increase depending on how busy the day of your visit is. This is called surge pricing, and is what they currently use for Lightning Lane selections, where on busier days, it'll cost you more to buy a ride. It looks like the current Disney Genie Plus cost is between \$15 – \$25 depending on when you visit. Busier times, like the weekends and holidays are going to have the higher Genie+ cost 2023, where slower days will be on the lower end.


HOW MANY RIDES HAVE LIGHTNING LANE AT DISNEY WORLD?

Guests will be happy to know that there are currently over forty rides which have the Lightning Lane at Disney World. However as you'll see below there are some restrictions regarding exactly how many rides you can access through the Lightning Lane at a time. Disney has also adjusted it's marketing to include that guests who upgrade to the Disney Genie+ can expect to access 2-3 Lightning Lanes on an average day. We do find it important to note that we have absolutely been able to arial.

HOW TO PURCHASE DISNEY GENIE+



In the next few screens you'll select your park and the date, and indicate the members of your party you would like to purchase Genie+ for. Follow the rest of the screens based on your party info and credit card information to pay. After the confirmation screen shown on the right below, Select continue to go back to either My Day or the Tip Board, depending on where you began your purchase.



MORE ABOUT LIGHTNING LANE SELECTIONS

HOW MANY LIGHTNING LANE PASSES PER DAY ARE YOU ALLOWED TO MAKE?

For guests using the Lightning Lane with their Genie+ they can make and hold up to one Lightning Lane reservation at a time, unless their reservation time is longer then 120 minutes away in which case they can make and hold two Lightning Lane reservations after that 120 minute mark. For this scenario, guests can make as many Lightning Lane reservations they can fit into one day as they can continue to make new Disney Genie+ Lightning Lane reservations as they go on each ride. This is of course based on ride availability as only a certain amount of Lightning Lanes are released for each ride each day and Disney has even confirmed that the Genie+ is expected to help guests get onto 2-3 attractions.

Guests who are looking to take advantage of the Disney World individual Lightning Lane premium selections can make up to two selections per day. It's important to note that guests can also stack one Disney Genie+ Lightning Lane with a Premium Lightning Lane selection at the same time.

CAN YOU MODIFY GENIE+ RESERVATIONS?

Guests are now able to modify Lightning Lane selections made with Disney Genie+ service, without having to cancel and rebook their selection. Guests can now quickly search for and select other available attractions or arrival windows, helping them maximize their time in the theme parks.

Guests may select the three dots icon on their Lightning Lane selection from the Tip Board or My Day tab of Disney Genie service, and then select "Modify Plan" from the menu that appears.

After selecting "Modify Plan," Lightning Lane experiences available at the park where the selection was originally made will appear. Guests may adjust their arrival window to a different time that is currently available, or may select a new experience to replace their Lightning Lane selection.

By selecting one of these options, the guest will be able to confirm the change. For guests who want to make a change for specific members of their party, they can adjust the party members prior to confirming the change.

HOW DOES LIGHTNING LANE WORK AT DISNEY WORLD?

- Upgrade to Disney Genie+ or select a premium Lightning Lane attraction
- Select your ride and receive your Lightning Lane return time
- Show up during your hour return time and scan in
- Enjoy your ride with little to no wait!

SIDE NOTE: INDIVIDUAL LIGHTNING LANE

HOW DOES IT WORK? IS IT THE SAME AS GENIE+?

- The Individual Lightning Lane is Genie+'s brother! They are both part of the paid version of the Genie service, which allow you to skip lines and select a particular time window to return.
- The main difference between both is that the Individual Lightning Lane is available for the most popular ride(s) at each park —at this time it is only available for 1 ride and it's purchased by ride; meaning that instead of paying a fixed amount for a bunch of rides, you'll pay a certain amount just for that particular ride.

HOW MUCH IS IT?

Here's when the tricky part comes, Individual Lightning Lane rides do not have a fixed price, it'll
depend on the date and ride. You can consider around \$7-\$15 per person, per ride.

WHEN DO I PURCHASE IT?

- Individual Lightning Lane can only be purchased the same day(s) of your visit(s), beginning 7AM for Resort Guests (i.e. you are staying on a Disney Hotel), and as soon as the park opens for off-site guests.
- These do sell out, so if you want to ensure you get a good chance here, we recommend purchasing as early as possible.

WHICH RIDES ARE INCLUDED?

- The list may vary, but here are some of the ones that as for now, are available for purchase:
 - > Star Wars Rise of The Resistance Hollywood Studios
 - > Guardians of the Galaxy: Cosmic Rewind Epcot
 - > Seven Dwarfs Mine Train Magic Kingdom
 - Avatar Flight of Passage Animal Kingdom

IS IT A MUST?

• It's hard to give a definite response, we do think if you take advantage of benefits like Early Entry (available for resort guests) or Evening Hours (just for Deluxe Resort Guests) and hit these rides during these hours – if they are available— you can save some money, however is completely up to you!

DISNEY GENIE+ TIPS

2 POSSIBLE STRATEGIES

Selecting the best strategy to use the Genie+ can be tricky, so we suggest two possible ways to use this new tool:

- 1. Filling the gaps: This strategy allows you to always book the most popular attraction regardless of the next return time window. You'll see some of the popular rides (we'll cover them shortly) will have longer windows to book a return time. For example, let's say it's 3PM and your ride of choice has the next available return time of 7:00 PM. This will leave you with a four-hour gap to fill. In this situation we suggest to fill this time in with some shows, or rides which have a lower wait time. Although this strategy will give you less selections throughout the day, we still find you'll be able to ride at least 5 of the most popular attractions. It's important to note that this can be a good strategy at EPCOT, Hollywood Studios, and Animal Kingdom however it's not always the best for Magic Kingdom due to the amount of rides at that park.
- 2. Get the most done: With this strategy you will always select the next available Disney Genie+booking return window. You will find that some families prefer the quantity over quality strategy as you can still work in 2-3 of the most popular rides, however maybe not all of them. Our suggestion for this strategy is to book one of the most popular rides as early as possible and then switch to the next available after that.

GENIE SERVICE: FREE PLANNING TOOL

On the My Disney Experience App, the Genie is a tool that will be super helpful for planning on the go and filling any gaps on your day! Simply add your preferences, must-do rides and interests, and the Genie will give you the best strategy to follow on that day, considering your current reservations and predicted wait times! Please note that even though the Genie will work only on the day of your visit, you can set up your preferences for each park in advance through the app (we recommend going for it to save time).

DISNEY GENIE+ TIPS

TIPS

- Remember to start making your Genie+ reservations at 7AM each day.
- Take Advantage of the Early Entry if staying at a Disney resort (30 minutes before official park opening, each day to any park of your choice) and do the rides that we will label as "Rides/Attractions to do first thing in the morning," these are not included with the Genie+.
- After you book your first Genie+ selection, you can book a second one when:
 - > Right after you redeem/go through the access point for your return time, you can select the next one (it may take a few minutes to show availability) but you don't have to wait until you get off the ride to select the next one.
 - > Your first return time window has ended (you missed it)
 - > 120 minutes have passed since you booked your last one (or 120 minutes after park opening if you made your first selection before the park opens).
- Get familiar with the Tip Board before your trip, you can open the My Disney Experience App, select the 3 lines on the bottom right, click "Tip Board" and look through the wait times and Genie+ booking times for each park. This will show you what the most popular rides are and help you determine which rides you will want to prioritize.
- Popular attractions in each park will sell out quickly. Slinky Dog Dash in Hollywood Studios sometimes sells out in seconds for Genie+ Lightning Lane.



IS DISNEY GENIE+ WORTH IT?

As a general rule of thumb we do find the Disney World Lightning Lane to be worth it if you can find a way to save 60 minutes per attraction at a cost of under \$11.00 per attraction. Based on the average wait times above this would also apply for popular attractions with wait times well over 60 minutes that also do cost more than \$11.00 such as Avatar Flight of Passage and Star Wars Rise of the Resistance. With the main reason here being that guests are still able to save a significant amount of time when compared to the \$11.00 per person per hour that they are spending to be inside of the Disney World parks.

- Peter Pans Flight: 70 Minutes on Average / \$7.33 Average Genie Plus Cost Per Ride = worth it
- Seven Dwarfs Mine Train: 76 Minutes on Average / \$11.00 Average Individual Lightning
 Lane Cost = worth it
- Space Mountain: 46 Minutes on Average / \$7.33 Average Genie Plus Cost
 Per Ride = not worth it
- Frozen Ever After: 84 Minutes on Average / \$7.33 Average Genie Plus Cost Per Ride = worth it
- Test Track: 69 Minutes on Average / \$7.33 Average Genie Plus Cost Per Ride = worth it
- Guardians of the Galaxy Cosmic Rewind: TBD as the ride moves away from virtual queue
- Avatar Flight of Passage: 103 Minutes on Average / \$14.00 Average Individual Lightning
 Lane Cost = worth it
- Kilimanjaro Safaris: 57 Minutes on Average / \$7.33 Average Genie Plus Cost Per Ride = worth it
- Star Wars Rise of the Resistance: 98 Minutes on Average \$16.00 Average Individual
 Lightning Lane Cost = worth it
- Slinky Dog Dash: 74 Minutes on Average \$7.33 Average Genie Plus Cost Per Ride = worth it
- Mickey and Minnie's Runaway Railway: 53 Minutes on Average \$7.33 Average Genie
 Plus Cost Per Ride = worth it

Now of course the important thing to keep in mind with the Disney Genie+ is the more rides and attractions you can accomplish within a day the lower your average wait time savings per ride can be. The main reason is that the Disney Genie+ is only costing you the flat fee of \$15-\$22 per person. So if you can get more then three rides out of it this will change your entire pay back period in a positive way.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Throughout all of the Disney theme parks, there are photographers stationed at the ready to snap photos. Any Walt Disney World or Disneyland guest is welcome to join a line and have their Disney World photos taken. This Disney World photography service is called Disney's PhotoPass.

When you're walking on Main Street, USA, or in front of the Tower of Terror, you're probably used to seeing the bright camera flashes. PhotoPass even has these unique opportunities called Magic Shots. The Magic Shots are Walt Disney World photos that have secret characters or special effects that appear once you receive your photo.

Our favorite thing about Disney World photos is that you don't need a Disney picture app. All of your Disney PhotoPass photos show up right in the My Disney Experience app for you to view. As long as you have your magic band, theme park ticket or Disney PhotoPass card, you can find them.

The Disney World Memory Maker is quite easy to use, and as long as you have your smartphone and a valid Disney ticket or MagicBand, you're all set to use it. The process is very simple and goes as such:

- 1. Disney PhotoPass Photographers take your pictures in front of iconic locations, at character dining experiences or character meet n' greets.
- 2. Your MagicBand, PhotoPass card or QR code is scanned and then your Disney pictures are send to your Disney account.
- 3. You are able to download Disney pictures or videos straight to your phone.



HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The Disney Memory Maker is the paid service that Walt Disney World offers to guests to retrieve their photos taken around the park. The Memory Maker price includes:

- Digital downloads of all Disney PhotoPass pictures and videos
- Certain attraction photos and videos
- Professional shots taken at iconic Disney locations by PhotoPass Photographers
- Magic Shots with appearances from special characters and more added into your Disney photos!

DISNEY MEMORY MAKER PRICE

- One Day Memory Maker \$69 Includes all photos and videos from one day of choice.
- Memory Maker Advance Purchase \$169 Includes all your photos and videos from one vacation period. Must wait at least 3 days after your purchase to activate.
- Memory Maker \$199 Includes all of your photos and videos from your vacation and is immediately available to use after purchase.

On-ride photos

If you ride certain Walt Disney World attractions they come with a PhotoPass shot. The photo will be automatically linked to your MyDisneyExperience app, or simply added with a scan of your MagicBand. There is nothing like getting off of some of your favorite Walt Disney World attractions and seeing silly photos taken during your ride.


Many of the attractions that PhotoPass pictures on them also have fun borders, or even videos taken on them. On Seven Dwarfs Mine Train, the Disney PhotoPass feature captures a couple seconds of you and your party on the ride right before the drop. There are also fun animations or themed videos that can accompany certain PhotoPass shots!



ANNUAL PASSES

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- During the limited capacity period, it may be difficult for Annual Passholders to get park reservations to visit on certain dates.
- All Annual Passholders are eligible to make theme park reservations for up to 3 days at a time, or Annual Passholders staying at select Disney Resort or other select hotels with valid theme park admission are eligible to make theme park reservations for each day of their stay(s). Once you use a theme park reservation, you can make another reservation for a future date.
- All reservations are subject to availability and applicable pass blockout dates. Guests should ensure their pass type is valid for park entry prior to making a park reservation. To enter one of the parks, each Passholder is required to have a theme park reservation in addition to a valid annual pass.
- As of 2023, new sales of annual passes are paused.

Bus Transportation

Disney's bus transportation system is a complimentary service that operates at Walt Disney World Resort. It is used to transport guests between the resort's theme parks, water parks, and hotels. The bus system is one of the primary modes of transportation for guests at the resort, and it is known for its efficiency and reliability. Buses are typically available at least 30 minutes before the theme parks and water parks open, and they run until approximately one hour after these parks close. There are a few parking options you will need to consider when planning your next Walt Disney World vacation.

What kind of options are there for parking at Disney World in Florida 2023?

- Standard
- Preferred
- Oversized vehicle

How much is parking at Disney theme parks in 2023?

- Standard parking: car or motorcycle \$25 per day (included for Disney hotel guests)
- Preferred parking: Disney world preferred car parking prices or motorcycle \$45-\$50 per day
- Oversized Vehicle Parking: Shuttle, Limo, Camper Trailer, RV, Bus or Tractor Trailer \$30 per day

It's important to note that at the parks, the Disney parking fee depends on the type of vehicle and if you're a hotel guest. Each theme park charges the same rate per day—once you pay for the day, you can park at any of the other theme parks.

Guests can also choose preferred parking—AKA a closer parking spot—by paying the difference in cost between the included standard parking and preferred parking (difference is currently \$20-\$25 per day). There are special preferred parking lots located close to the theme park entrances. Pricing is seasonal and may vary based on your date of visit.

Parking at the water parks

• Standard parking at Disney World water parks—Disney's Typhoon Lagoon and Disney's Blizzard Beach—is **free** for all guests!

Resort parking

There is a nightly parking charge for guests staying at a Walt Disney World hotel.

Overnight Self-Parking

Standard overnight self-parking is available to registered guests for a Disney World parking fee that will be applied to your hotel tab upon check-out. The Disney resort parking fee includes applicable tax.

Disney Value Resorts: \$15 per night

Disney Moderate Resorts: \$20 per night

Disney Deluxe and Deluxe Villa Resorts: \$25 per night

Disney Springs Parking

Self-parking in the surface parking lots and parking garages is free. Typically, valet parking (\$20) is available in the following three areas:

- Near the entrance to the Orange Garage from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.
- On West Side in front of Cirque du Soleil from 4:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.
- In the Lemon Lot near the World of Disney shop from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Electric Vehicle Charging

If you have an electric car, there are a number of ChargePoint charging stations available in parking lots at the parks. Additionally, the Coronado Springs and Wilderness Lodge resorts have ChargePoint stations.

The Disney EV Charging Stations Disney World are located here:

- Magic Kingdom parking: five spaces—one space at the front of the Medical Parking Lot and four spaces at the front of the Zurg Parking Lot
- EPCOT: four spaces at the front of the Journey Parking Lot
- Disney Animal Kingdom parking: four spaces in the Medical Parking Lot
- Disney's Hollywood Studios: four spaces at the front of the Mickey Parking Lot
- Disney Springs: nine spaces—three on the 5th floor of the Orange Garage, three on the
 5th floor of the Lime Garage and three spaces on the 3rd floor of the Grapefruit Garage
- Disney's Coronado Springs Resort: six spaces in general parking near ADA spaces
- Disney's Riviera Resort: two spaces in general parking near ADA spaces
- Disney's Wilderness Lodge: two spaces in general parking near ADA spaces

To use this service, you will need a credit card or a pre-ordered ChargePoint card. The Disney World park parking cost to charge at these stations is \$0.35 per kilowatt hour, with a minimum service amount of \$1.50. Charging will stop once the vehicle's battery is fully charged. ChargePoint will "ping" the owners to alert them when their car is ready.

DISNEY'S TABLE SERVICE DINING (TS):

- A wide variety of restaurants that offer sit-down meals.
- · Reservations required.
- Many include Character dining.
- Each restaurant has a different cuisine, so you have a variety of options to choose from.

Enhanced Technology

- Mobile Order Service (MO): A time-saving feature of the My Disney Experience app, mobile order service enables you to order ahead at select dining lo- cations and pick up food during a designated arrival window.
- Mobile Check-In for Reservations: Check in to your dining reservations at select table-service restaurants using the new mobile check-in featu- re on the My Disney Experience app.
 There's no need to visit the host stand to check in!
- Scannable Codes for Select Restaurant Menus: While at a table-service restaurant, you
 can use your own mobile device to scan a code for access to the digital menu.
- Cashless Payments: At this time, it is recommended all Guests use cashless payment options, including debit cards, credit cards and Disney Gift Cards. Guests can also opt for contactless payment options—such as mobile wallets—or use cash to purchase a Disney Gift Card at Guest Relations and select merchandise locations. Disney Resort hotel Guests can also use MagicBands to charge their purchase to their Disney Resort hotel folio.

Disney Dining Tips:

- Reservations for popular restaurants, such as Cinderella's Castle and Be Our Guest, tend
 to get booked up quickly (especially during peak seasons), so securing your dining reservations ahead of time is a MUST!
- To find out if you will be traveling during peak season, check out our Disney World Crowd Calendar.

- You can make Disney dining reservations up to 180 days prior to your arrival date. Guests staying at a WDW Resort receive an extra 10 days to make Disney dining reservations, so 190 days in total.
- You don't have to be staying at a certain WDW resort to make a reservation at that resort, however you do have to have a valid theme park ticket if you plan on dining inside of that theme park.
- Credit Card Guarantee
- WDW does require a credit card to make any and all dining reservations. Your card will NOT be charged at the time of making your reservations, this policy is to avoid any no shows/last minute cancellations.
- You have a 2 hour window prior to your reservation to cancel. Otherwise, your card will be charged \$10 per person included in the reservation.
- To avoid the cancellation fee after the 2 hour window has passed, a minimum of one person from your party must arrive at your scheduled dining time.
- Select restaurants do require prepayment as they have pre-fixed menus. These full service restaurants are:


