WHAT MAKES UP UNIVERSAL ORLANDO?

● ***Universal Studios Florida***

Universal Studios is the first park that opened with Universal Orlando resort in 1990. Universal Studios Florida is known for its movie-themed rides and attractions, which allow visitors to "ride the movies" and experience their favorite films and television shows in a whole new way.

● ***Islands of Adventure***

is one of two original Universal theme parks in the United States, along with Universal Studios Florida. Islands of Adventure is known for its immersive and interactive rides and attractions, which are based on popular franchises such as Marvel Comics, Jurassic Park, and The Wizarding World of Harry Potter.

● ***Universal's Volcano Bay***

Is Universal's first and only water theme park. Volcano Bay is a tropical-themed water park that features a variety of water rides, attractions, and experiences. Some of the most popular attractions at Volcano Bay include the Krakatau Aqua Coaster, the Punga Racers slide, and the Waturi Beach wave pool.

● ***Universal's CityWalk***

A dining, shopping, and entertainment complex located at Universal Orlando Resort in Florida. It is located between Universal Studios Florida and Universal's Islands of Adventure, and is accessible to visitors of both theme parks. CityWalk Orlando is home to a wide variety of restaurants, bars, shops, and entertainment venues, including live music and performance venues, a movie theater, and a mini golf course. CityWalk Orlando is a great place to grab a bite to eat, do some shopping, or enjoy some nightlife after a day at the theme parks.

When is the best time to visit?

We do typically find the best time to visit Universal Orlando in 2023 to be January, February, August, and September based on crowd projections and also the most recent deals and promotions going on at the parks.

Based on events and traffic of years past, the least crowded days to visit Universal Studios in are:

A popular question we receive is "do we need park reservations for Universal Orlando"

- NO, you do not need to make any park reservations for Universal Studios, Islands of Adventure or Volcano Bay. All you need is a valid park ticket for entry.
- There is also no "park hopping time." If you have a park-to-park ticket, you can hop back and forth between Islands of Adventure and Universal Orlando at any time.

What is Early Park Admission?

Universal Orlando's Early Park Admission is a perk available to guests staying at select on-site hotels at Universal Orlando Resort and those who purchase tickets with The Park Prodigy. With this perk, guests are able to enter one of the theme parks (either Universal Studios Florida or Islands of Adventure) up to **one hour** before the park opens to the general public. This can be a great way to experience some of the most popular attractions with shorter wait times, as well as get a head start on the day before the crowds arrive.

To take advantage of Early Park Admission, you'll need to show a valid room key or Key to the World card (for on-site hotel guests) or Universal Orlando vacation package confirmation letter (for package guests) at the park turnstiles. Only guests staying at select on-site hotels are eligible for Early Park Admission.

Please note that the availability and schedule of Early Park Admission is subject to change and may vary based on the time of year and other factors. It's always a good idea to check the schedule for Early Park Admission in advance of your visit, so you can plan your day accordingly.

PLANNING YOUR TRIP

How to get there

Figuring out how to get around can be a huge part of planning a vacation, and that is especially important for navigating to your hotel from the airport. Many guests choose to fly into the Orlando International Airport for their Universal vacation.

Airport

Universal Orlando Resort is located about 14 miles from the Orlando International Airport (MCO), which is the main airport in and out of Orlando. It is the closest airport to Universal Studios Florida

- Typically, the drive from Universal Orlando to MCO will take between 20 – 30 minutes depending on how heavy traffic is during your travel time. That can change if you are on a shared shuttle bus or van, which could take anywhere from 45 minutes to an hour

What kind of transportation from Orlando airport to Universal?

- Rental Cars
- Shuttle Bus or Van
- Rideshare Apps (Lyft or Uber)
- Public transportation

Universal Orlando SuperStar Shuttle - guests can book as an add-on to their vacation to take them to one of the 8 Universal Orlando hotels. The Universal SuperStar Shuttle picks guests up on the Ground Transportation level of the airport and transports guests from there to their hotels.

This trip on the Universal SuperStar Shuttle can take as little as 30 minutes on a low traffic day, but usually takes about 45 minutes before you're at your hotel.

- Adult (\$39) - Roundtrip
- Child (\$29) - Roundtrip
- Adult (\$23) - One Way
- Child (\$18) - One Way

How much is Uber from Orlando airport to Universal Studios?

An Uber ride from the airport to Universal Studios can cost anywhere from \$30 – \$100 depending on when and where you decide to travel. There are also different options for vehicles you can choose, from just a regular passenger car to UberXL, which are larger cars for more space.

- Regular Uber \$28 – \$35
- UberXL – \$35 – \$60
- Uber Black (Premium Car Choice) – \$60 – \$90

Can I take a taxi from Orlando Airport to Universal Studios?

Yes, there are traditional taxis that travel from the Orlando Airport to Universal Studios. If you're not looking to use an app on your phone and prefer to travel by a metered taxi, you can hop in one right on the Ground Transportation level of the pickup area. The metered taxi price is determined by mileage and time, and for Universal ends up being between \$38 – \$50 per ride, one way.

How much does it cost to rent a car from the Orlando Airport to Universal Studios?

Renting a car to get from the airport to Universal can cost as low as about \$25 a day, to upwards of \$100 depending on what you're looking for. Many mid-sized vehicles average at about \$50 a day, no matter which car rental company you go with. On top of the base pricing, you also have to factor in paying for gas in your budget.

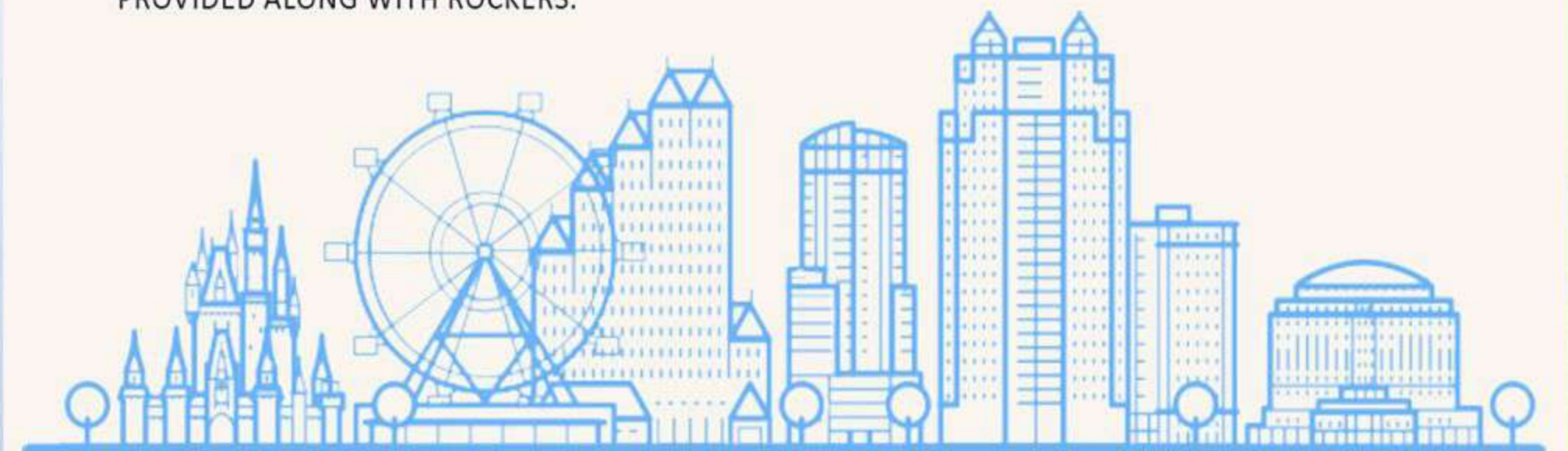

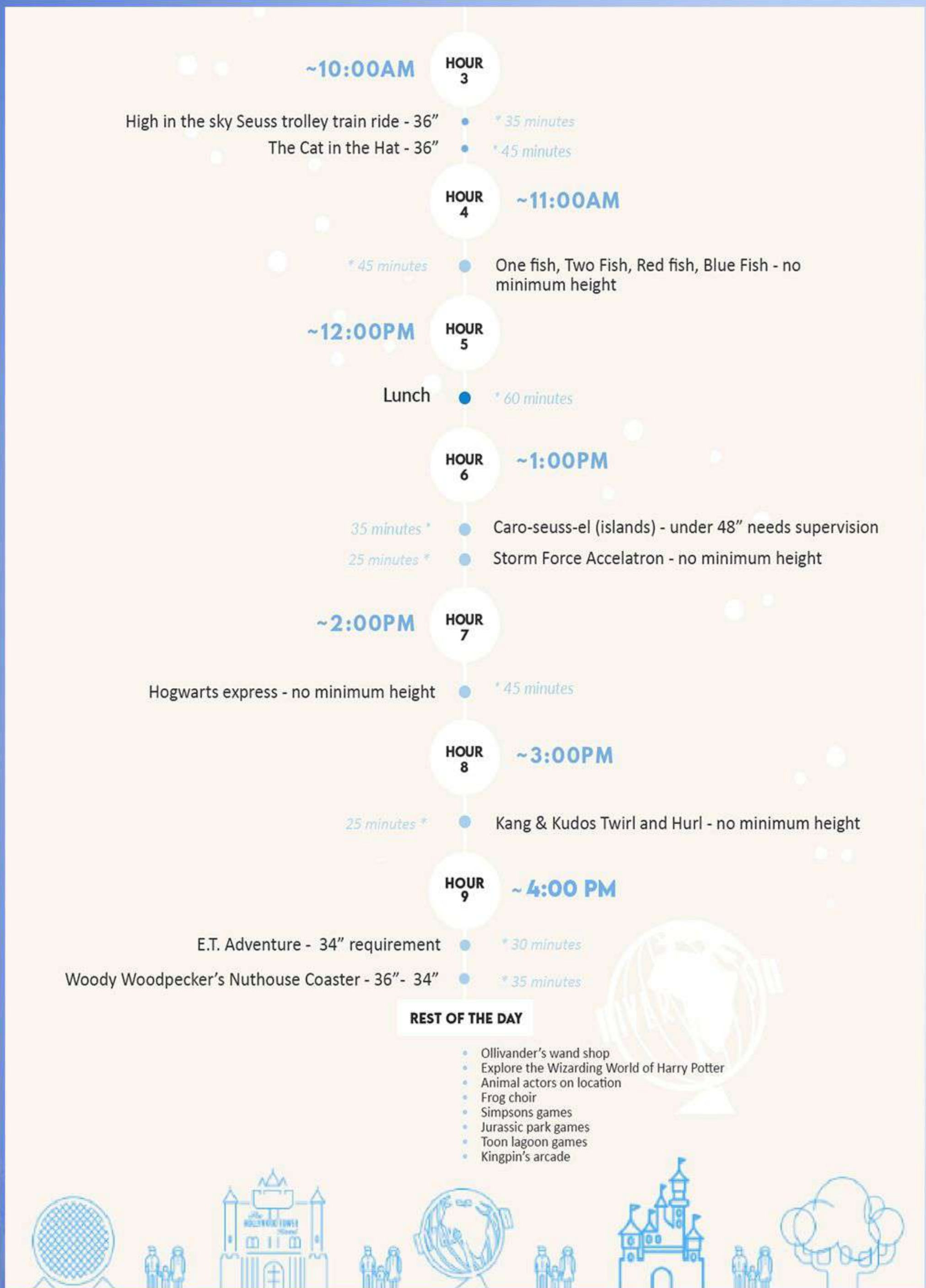

Universal Orlando provides free transportation to and from their hotels to CityWalk and Volcano Bay.

Bus: Universal Orlando Resort operates a complimentary bus service that transports guests between the on-site hotels, theme parks, and CityWalk.

- All Universal Orlando Resorts have bus transportation to CityWalk and Volcano Bay
- Endless Summer Dockside & Surfside only have bus transportation available, no water taxi or walking path.
- The busses run very often - about every 10 minutes.



Walking: It is possible to walk between the theme parks, hotels, and CityWalk, although some areas may be farther apart and require a longer walk.

- The closest hotel to Universal Orlando CityWalk (Islands of Adventure and Universal Studios Florida) is the Hard Rock Hotel followed by Portofino Bay and Royal Pacific Resort.
- The furthest hotel is Cabana Bay Beach Resort which is a 25-30 minute walk.
- Cabana Bay Beach Resort is the closest walking distance to Volcano Bay, it is just steps away.

Car: If you are driving to Universal Orlando Resort, on-site parking is available at all of the theme parks and CityWalk.

Special Note: Base tickets do NOT give you access to the Hogwarts Express. However base tickets are usually the cheapest discount ticket to Universal Orlando.

Universal Orlando Base Tickets

PROS

The Universal Orlando base ticket is the perfect ticket for families who would like to take their time exploring one theme park per day. We also find it to be a better fit for families with small children so that you don't have to worry about traveling between parks with the little ones.

As a general rule of thumb, the base tickets are always going to be the cheapest Universal Orlando ticket option when compared to the park-to-park tickets.

CONS

It's important to note that the Universal Orlando base ticket will not allow guests to ride on the Hogwarts Express. It's also not the best fit for families who are only visiting Universal Orlando for one day precisely for the Wizarding World of Harry Potter. The main reason being the Wizarding World of Harry Potter is split between both Islands of Adventure theme park and Universal Studios Florida.

Universal Orlando Park-to-Park Tickets

A Universal Orlando Park-to-Park ticket gives you the flexibility to go between the parks each day of your visit.

Special Note: Park-to-Park tickets do give you access to the Hogwarts Express.

Universal Orlando Park-to-Park Tickets

PROS


The Universal Orlando park-to-park ticket is the perfect fit for families who want the ultimate flexibility within their day to visit more than one theme park. For this reason, we find it to be the perfect ticket for families with older kids and teens who would like to enjoy longer days in the parks.

The Universal Orlando park-to-park ticket also includes the Hogwarts express. For this reason, we find the one day, two-park park-to-park ticket to be the perfect fit for families who are only visiting Universal Orlando to visit The Wizarding World of Harry Potter.

CONS

As a general rule of thumb, the Universal Orlando park-to-park ticket is always going to be more expensive than the base ticket.



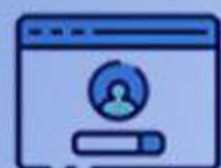

HOW TO PURCHASE UNIVERSAL ORLANDO TICKETS



Step #1: Choose Your Start Date to View Ticket Pricing

The start date you select will determine your **Universal Orlando discount ticket pricing**. One-day tickets must be used on the date selected; however, a multi-day ticket will have a validity window to give you more flexibility.

MULTI-DAY TICKETS

2-Day – Use within 5 days of the chosen start date

3-Day – Use within 6 days of the chosen start date

4-Day – Use within 7 days of the chosen start date

5-Day – Use within 8 days of the chosen start date



Step #2: Pick Between 2-Park Tickets or 3-Park Tickets

A **2-Park Universal ticket** gives you access to Universal Studios Florida and Universal's Islands of Adventure.

A **3-Park Universal ticket** gives you access to Universal Studios Florida, Universal's Islands of Adventure and Universal's Volcano Bay water theme park.



Step #3 Pick Between Base Tickets or Park-to-Park

A **Universal Orlando Base ticket** gives you access to one park per day. These will also typically be the cheapest discount tickets for Universal Studios Orlando.

A **Universal Orlando Park-to-Park ticket** gives you the flexibility to go between the parks each day of your visit.



Step #4: Redeem your tickets right outside the park gates

All guests who purchase their **discount tickets to Universal Studios Orlando** from theparkprodigy.com will receive a ticket confirmation number directly from Universal. This confirmation number will be used to pick your tickets up from any of the ticket kiosks or will call booths at Universal Orlando.

HOW TO PICK UP UNIVERSAL ORLANDO TICKETS

- To pick up your discounted tickets from The Park Prodigy:
- Simply bring your reservation number and your original form of payment (for identity verification only) to any of the Universal ticket (will call) kiosks, guest relations windows, or will call booths, the morning of your trip to redeem your tickets. If you don't have the card used for purchase, head to the ticket booth and present a Valid ID matching the lead guest's name listed on the reservation.
- Please be sure to keep your original ticket if visiting for multiple days, as that will be your ticket for all days in the parks. You do not have to visit the ticket kiosk every morning.
- Keep in mind that your tickets come with Early Park Admission, which will allow you to enter the parks one hour before they officially open! Usually one of the two parks has EPA available, so we highly recommend checking the Universal Orlando App to confirm availability during your travel dates. Remember to check which attractions will be open during that extra hour. It is important to note that Universal recently announced the newest ride the VelociCoaster will also be available for Early Park Admission!
- The guest relations windows and will call booths open up a half hour before your Early Park Admission so you would have a good amount of time to pick up your tickets and take advantage of that extra hour in the parks!
- Also, as the party leader, please be sure to carry a valid ID as this might be required when entering the park.

UNIVERSAL ORLANDO EXPRESS PASS

What are the Universal Express Pass Options?

- Basic Universal Express Pass – Skip the regular lines one time per participating attractions in the theme parks
- Universal Express Unlimited Pass – Skip lines an unlimited amount of times at participating attractions in the theme parks
- Volcano Bay Express PLUS Pass – Skip the lines one time at ALL participating attractions at Volcano Bay
- Volcano Bay Express Pass – Skip the lines at SELECT participating attractions at Volcano Bay.

How Express Pass Works at Universal Orlando?

Once you've purchased your Universal Orlando Express Passes, you can head into the parks and start using! This is a feature that's on the Universal Orlando app. Unlike the Disney Fast Pass experience, there is no return time for Universal Orlando Express Passes. Therefore, you can head in and start searching for the big yellow signs outside of line queues labeled "Express Pass." Before you enter the queue, a team member will scan your Universal Express Pass ticket and allow you to pass through the line.

What is the Universal Express Pass Cost?

Basic Express Pass

- 1 Park Per Day – Starting at \$79.99 all ages per ticket
- 2 Park Per Day – Starting at \$89.99 all ages per ticket

Express Pass Unlimited:

- 1 Park Per Day – Starting at \$109.99 all ages per ticket (or included with your stay at a Universal Premier Hotel)
- 2 Park Per Day – Starting at \$119.99 all ages per ticket (Or included in your stay at a Universal Premier Hotel)

Volcano Bay Express Pass:

- Universal Volcano Bay Express Pass – Starting at \$19.99 per ticket, per day

Volcano Bay Express Plus Pass:

- Universal Volcano Bay Express Plus Pass – Starting at \$39.99 per ticket, per day

For the rules of each pass, they are fairly simple to follow. The basic Universal Express Pass allows guests to enter the Express Lane one time per participating attraction. Where as the Universal Express Pass Unlimited allows guests visiting Universal to ride participating rides an unlimited amount of times. Last, but not least, Universal does offer an Express Pass for Volcano Bay, which is the water park at Universal Orlando Resort.

One of the perks of staying at a Universal Orlando Premier Hotel is that the Universal Express Unlimited is included for all guests registered to the room for the length of the stay! The Universal Orlando Resort Premier Hotels are Loews Portofino Bay, Hard Rock Hotel, Loews Royal Pacific Hotel.

You will notice that the 2 most popular attractions, Hagrid's Magical Creatures Motorbike Adventure and Jurassic World VelociCoaster are NOT included with the Express Pass.

Do Express Passes Sell Out?

Absolutely. We can not impress enough that regardless of the price, Express Passes do sell out.

Unlike the Genie+ system at Disney World, this pay to skip the line program does and will sell out. Now this will depend on the time of year you decide to visit. If your trip is planned around the conventional "slow time" of the year (January-March), you will most likely not have a problem with passes selling out. But if you are visiting in the summer months, or the week before or after a major holiday, you do run that risk. Especially the longer you wait to commit to purchasing the pass.

Can I Share my Express Pass with Another Guest?

No, you can not share Express Passes with another person in your party.

With all of the differences between Universal and Disney, you might be wondering, can you share Universal Express Pass? And unfortunately this is a similarity the Universal skip the line pass systems share. No, your Express Pass may not be used for another ticket other than your own. Since the pass is linked to your specific ticket, it is simply impossible to use one pass for more than one ticket. In order for other guests in your party to experience the Express Pass with you, each guest must purchase their own pass.

Can You Buy Universal Express Pass Inside the Parks 2023?

Absolutely! Passes may be purchased at the ticket kiosks or at the ticketing booths.

So, you've booked your trips and gotten down to Universal Orlando Resort and realized it's much more crowded than you thought. That is okay! Universal Orlando Resort allows guests to purchase Express Passes the day of your theme park trip.

Do Universal Orlando Express Passes have Return Times?

No! The Universal Orlando express pass does not have return times. Once you receive your Universal express pass ticket, you can start heading into the parks and having fun! Just remember that there are rides that do not participate in express pass.

What is the Average Wait Time with Universal Express Pass?

Universal Orlando wait times with Express Pass are significantly less than standby. Usually only about 5-10 minutes with average crowd levels. Let's say you visit on a weekend and most Universal Thrill Rides are over an hour wait. With the passes, you are only going to be waiting a fraction of that, like 10-12 minutes, on participating attractions.

Tips and Tricks for how to use Express Pass at Universal Studios 2023

- Pro Tip! – Do not use your Universal Express pass on a line queue that is 15 minutes or under. Most likely, the Stand-By line will be almost walk on, therefore you will be wasting your basic Express Pass ticket. If you have the Unlimited Express Pass, it won't matter much when you go.
- You cannot use your Express Pass during Early Park Admission
- Express Passes have date-based pricing, the slower the time of year, the cheaper your theme park and Universal Orlando Express Passes will be.
- Express passes can sell out! If you're going during a very busy time, like Christmastime, make sure to purchase your tickets in advance.
- Do not ride the most popular Express Pass rides first. Follow our rides list above to save the most time waiting in line for rides with your Express Pass.

UNIVERSAL VIP EXPERIENCE

What is the VIP Experience?

What is the Universal VIP tour? The 2023 Universal VIP tour provides guests with a Universal expert who leads them through the most popular shows and rides, plus they will receive special benefits before and after, such as free meals and a Universal express pass ticket. The Universal VIP experience is currently being offered at both Universal Orlando Resort as well as Universal Studios Hollywood. And as you'll see below both the Universal Studios Orlando VIP tour and Universal Hollywood VIP tour are sold in private and non-private settings.

How long does the Universal VIP tour last?

As a general rule of thumb the Universal VIP tours will last between 5-7 hours depending on the type of tour you select. The Universal Orlando VIP tour will generally be between 6-7 hours while the Universal Studios Hollywood VIP tour will be between 5-6 hours. It's also important to note that one of the benefits of the Universal VIP tour is that guests can enjoy the theme parks before their tour starts, and can stay in the park until park closing after their VIP tour is over with the use of their Universal express pass.

How early should you arrive for your Universal VIP Tour?

One of the most useful tips and tricks we can provide to get the most out of your Universal Orlando VIP tour is to arrive at least 45-60 minutes before your tour even begins. One of the main reasons is it will take you some time to get through security at Universal, and then once you do arrive to the park gates your group will still have to check in to your VIP experience. We also find that arriving early gives you plenty of time to take advantage of breakfast in the morning if that's something that is important to you. We also enjoyed getting to meet with our Universal VIP tour guide and coming up with a game plan for how the entire group would prefer to tackle the parks.

What are the two Universal Orlando VIP tours?

- Universal Orlando non-private VIP tour
- Private Universal Orlando VIP tour

Does Universal VIP include Hagrid?

All Universal Orlando VIP tours include front of the line access to all rides and attractions within the theme parks, and that includes Hagrid's Magical Creatures Motorbike Adventure, the VeolciCoaster, and the Pteranodon Flyers. The main reason why this is so important is these three rides are not included with the Universal Orlando express pass.



NON-Private VIP Tour

The non-private Universal Orlando VIP tour begins at 11:00 AM each morning, and typically lasts between five and seven hours. We will also say that even though guests follow the Universal tour guides lead on average they are guaranteed to get on average of ten rides.

What is included in the Universal Orlando non-private VIP tour?

- Front of the line access to Universal Orlando shows and rides
- Backstage tour and knowledge from your tour guide

Universal Orlando VIP experience cost?

It's also important to note that a valid Universal Orlando park-to-park admission ticket is required as well to participate in the Universal Orlando VIP tour.

Private VIP Tour

The private Universal Orlando VIP tour is required for groups of seven or more who wish to upgrade to the Universal Orlando VIP experience. The biggest difference between the private VIP and non-private VIP is that during the private VIP tour the guests have final say in which rides their group will go on throughout the eight hour tour. We think this makes a huge difference because if your private tour group decides they would like to ride Hagrid's Magical Creatures Motorbike Adventure or the VelociCoaster over and over again you could absolutely do that!

What is included in the Universal Orlando Private VIP tour?

Private VIP tour Universal Orlando Cost?

- The Universal Studios private VIP tour costs start at \$3,099 for the two park – one day private VIP experience for up to five guests, and additional guests will start at \$375 per person each. The private VIP tours at Universal Orlando can accommodate up to ten guests.

It's also important to note that these are the starting costs and the final price can fluctuate based on the time of year that you are visiting.

For a flat fee you will have access to unlimited digital copies of all of your Universal photos within the parks and on the participating rides. That means the thrilling moments on rides, awesome character interactions and even perfect moments can be captured and kept as memories or even turned into specialized merchandise! The My Universal Photo package is an extra add on that can be purchased before or during your Universal vacation.

Next, once you are logged in, set up your wallet. Within the wallet you will want to add in a credit card to use for onsite purchases through Universal Pay. Using Universal Pay was so easy throughout our day – we used it to pay for food and purchase souvenirs throughout the theme parks.

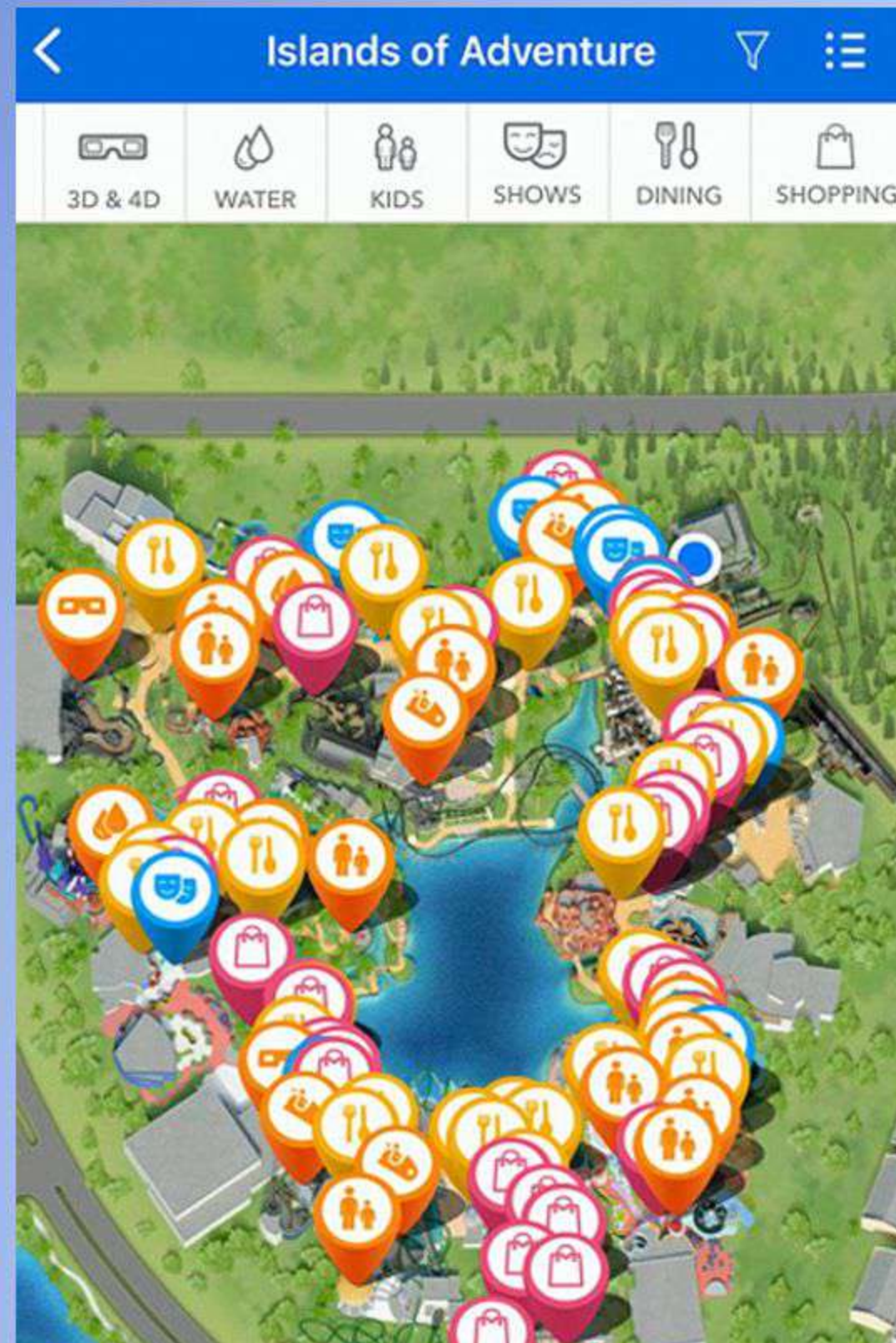
If you are going to Volcano Bay, make sure to set up sub accounts under your account and set spending limits for every member of your traveling party who you may want to be able to purchase through Universal Pay by tapping their Tapu Tapu anywhere Universal Pay is accepted in the park. This allows anyone traveling with you to be able to make purchases throughout Volcano Bay without having to carry cash or cards (in their bathing suit).

- Actively Use The App As You Make Your Way Around the Parks

As simple as it sounds, make sure to actively use your app when you are in the parks to navigate your day.

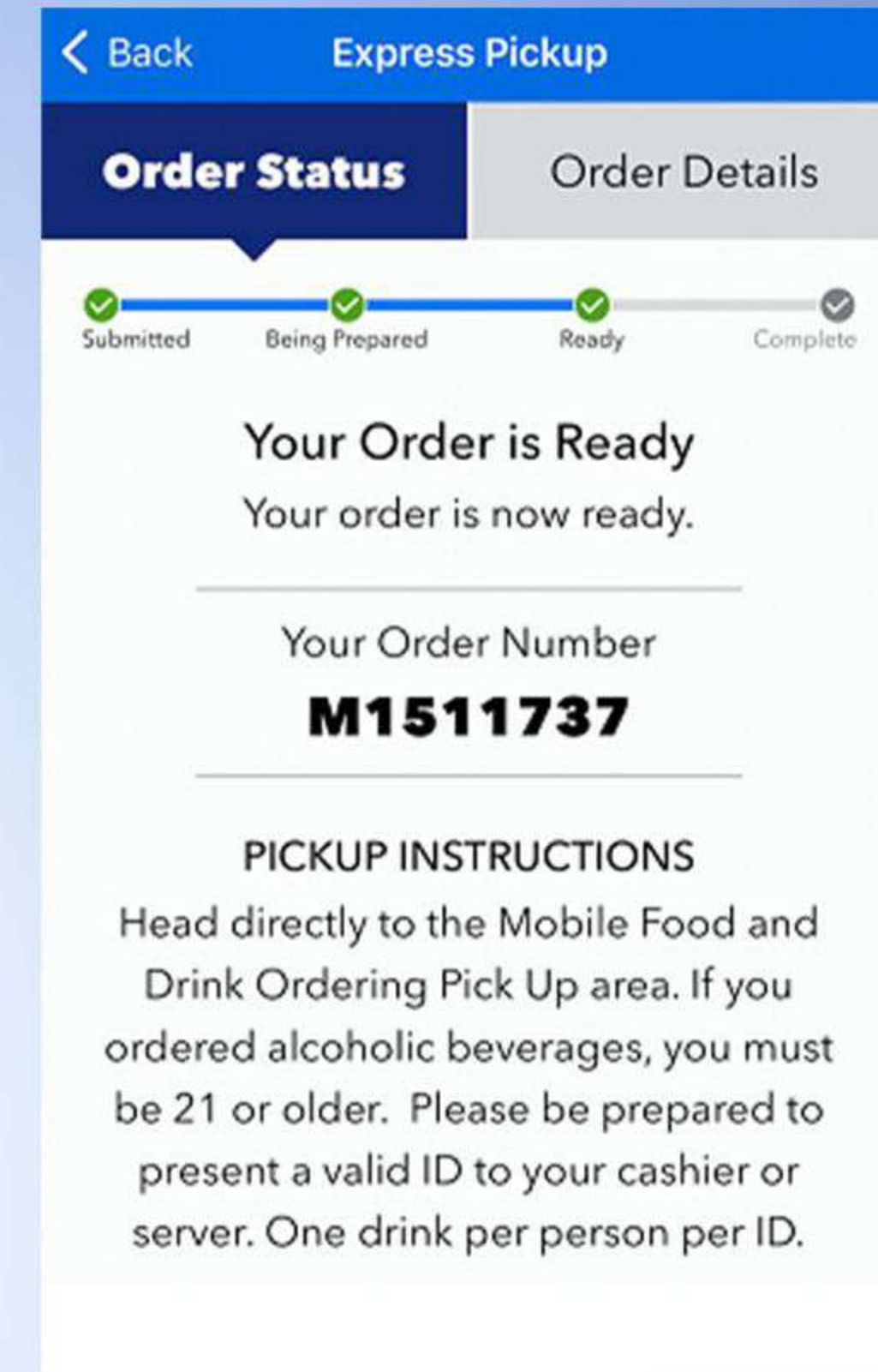
There are a bunch of features to use while in the parks:

Map: Allow the app to use your location and help find your way around the parks. Use the navigation at the top of the map to filter between Thrill rides, 3D & 4D rides, Water rides, Kids rides, Shows, Dining and Shopping. We used the map multiple times a day to make sure we are going the right direction and to find everything we need — from restaurants and attractions, to shops, and — most importantly — nearby bathrooms



Ride Info: Click on Rides within the home page of the app or click on the ride icons within the Map to view information about each ride. Here you can view all the ride details including child swap, single rider line details, height requirements and wait times. You can also set a wait time alarm that will alert you when the wait time on your selected ride has gone down to a pre-set time. We referenced the ride info throughout the day to see wait times, look for child swap info and set alarms for a few of the rides she wanted to take on that had longer wait times. It also helps being able to check right in the app which rides accept Universal Express!

Mobile Food & Drink Ordering: This allows you to select from several quick service restaurants throughout the theme parks and order your food in advance. You can even customize orders for special dietary requirements and requests. Some venues will have a mobile ordering pickup area while others will bring the food directly to your table — just follow the directions in the app!



UniversalPay: Pay for purchases throughout the parks using just your phone. Simply pull up the Wallet within the app and click on Universal Pay for a QR code to scan when making purchases. As long as your credit card has been added in the app, this will work at most merchandise and quick service food locations throughout Universal Orlando Resort.

Virtual Line Experience: At busier times of the year, use the official app to choose a Virtual Line return time for select attractions at Universal Studios Florida and Universal's Islands of Adventure.

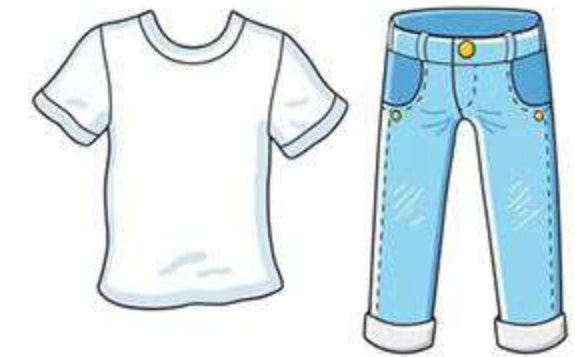
