The Magic Kingdom Park is by far the most-visited theme park at Walt Disney World, being home to so many classic Disney attractions such as the Haunted Mansion and Peter Pan's Flight, as well as new favorites such as The Seven Dwarfs Mine Train and Tron Lightcycle Run. With more than double the attractions of any other theme park, it's no surprise The Magic Kingdom Park has something for everyone to do, from the young to the young at heart.

Our team members at The Park Prodigy have put together this itinerary for you to get the most out of your day at The Magic Kingdom! It has been updated to avoid long lines and crowds and maximize your time in the parks. One of the essential aspects to help make the most out of your time in the parks is to A) Arrive Early and B) Leave late when you can. We recommend arriving 45-60 minutes ahead of the park opening, allowing you to take advantage of lower wait times on some of the most popular attractions.

It's also important to note that many times guests can only access some of the newest rides through the Disney World virtual queue system which can be accessed by downloading the My Disney Experience app. For more information on how the virtual queue works simply google "The Park Prodigy Disney World virtual queue" for a complete guide on our blog.

This Magic Kingdom itinerary does NOT include a midday break and does NOT include Disney the Disney Multi-pass which is the pay to skip the line system. We find it to be best suited for families with older children and young teens. We recommend at least two days at the Magic Kingdom to take advantage of everything the park offers. However, we understand that this doesn't always fit into the plan, so here we go!
